Why should you read the SSRYA books?

• For a chance to participate in Battle of the Books!

So, what are the rewards?

- All Books: Brag tags for each book read to display on backpack
- 3 Books: One scoop of ice cream at end of year party
- 5 Books: Second scoop of ice cream at party
- 6+ Books: One topping for each book read after 6
- 12 Books: Try out for Battle of the Books team!
- 15 Books: Your name on the morning announcements, photo on SSYRA wall of fame in media center, attendance at Battle of the Books; additional specialty tag for reading all 15 books

How do I prove I've read the books?

You will take a short quiz for each book you read in order to get credit for it.

Deadline

The deadline to read and test in <u>12 books</u> so that you can qualify for the Battle of the Books team is <u>March 1</u>. Tryouts for the team will be held the week of <u>March 4</u>.

The deadline to read and test in <u>15 books</u> so that you can attend the Battle of the Books to watch the competition is <u>April 12</u>.

You can continue to read books, earn brag tags, and earn extra treats at the ice cream party up until the party is held in May.

How will Battle of the Books work?

All students in grades 3-5 who have read at least 12 books will take a quiz to qualify for the Battle of the Books team. The students with the 5 highest scores will make up our team. The students with the next 2 highest scores will be alternates for the team. During the actual Battle of the Books competition, our team will answer questions about the books. So that means our team members need to be experts!
