Looking back last Fall, the Boosterthon Fun Run began our year by raising just over \$17,000 for media center improvements. This money will be spent on new furniture and shelves to replace the ones that have fallen into disrepair over the last 20 years. The remainder of the fund will be spent to improve technology in the media center. Our Media Specialist, Mrs. Moukhliis, is thrilled to be able to make these improvements this Spring. In addition to Media Center improvements, \$4,000 in funds from Boosterthon were sent directly to teachers for use in their classrooms. None of this would have been possible without your support of the Boosterthon Fun Run.

Many other projects are being funded this year with PTO funds, and I will attempt to list just a few of them here: 20 high volume laser printers and toner cartridges for classrooms, new furniture for the entrance hallway,

faculty area improvements, additional playground equipment for 5th grade, new patio furniture for the faculty patio, new patio furniture for the media center patio.

In closing, I'd like to thank the PTO executive board and committee chairs for their tireless work on behalf of our school. Our PTO works, because of their heart and dedication.
