

SAC Minutes -- October 12, 2021

Kourtney Williams motioned to start the meeting at 3:09pm. Coram was reached.

Minutes from September SAC meeting were motioned to approve by Kelsey Cravey, seconded by Tammy Carter. Approved.

Kourtney let O'Connell speak about the Principal Report. Goal is to have everyone reading on grade level by 3rd grade, utilizing NEST groups. All grade levels are participating, Kindergarten will begin next week. Data checks are complete for 4th and 5th grades. Report Cards come out next week, planning day on Monday. New Reagan Initiative for tutoring after school being finalized, information will be available to parents soon. Literacy Parade will be on the 29th, information will come out this Friday. Christmas Shop will be open on the stage this November. No math curriculum adoption will be needed.

Budget review: 2,728.56. Sam question: "The school recognition funds, 19,000, they are different from the money being distributed to staff?" O'Connell: "They are from the same pot. The Grade School money we will not get this year." Proposed the idea of using SAC money to distribute for recognition or use it for school improvement. Ideas for staff recognition distribution model put on the agenda for next SAC meeting.

Moved on to Funds Request from Minda Gordon in Music Therapy for Social-Emotional Learning Goals: \$500. Kelsey Cravey motions to approve, Sam Horowitz seconds the motion. Funds Request of \$500 approved to the Music Therapy program.
