

SAC Meeting Notes November 9th

Quorum was reached and meeting was called to order by Kourtney Williams at 3:05.

Katherine O'Connell motioned to approve the October minutes; Sam Horowitz was second.

Principal briefing: Intensive reading program grant from the state, where CCE has begun an intensive reading program in 3rd grade. Spelling Bee on the 16th for 5th grade! iReady lessons are being passed more than 80%, and 60% of the students in the school are hitting the goal of 30 minutes. Literacy goal for students: 25+ books read.

SIP Focus: Positive School Culture (Happy Campers, students are engaged!) and Conscious Discipline. SIP Goals: 2.5% goal for growth in ELA, CCE to remain an A school. District focus is on subgroups of students present at CCE (students with disabilities and economically disadvantaged students are the focus on CCE; 10% growth; focus on inclusion for students with disabilities and data-based decision making). Seeing an increase in absences this school year.

Staff Recognition Distribution: \$19,000. Focus on recognition and classroom goals. Offer the opportunity to staff for the request of funds. This is rollover SAC money from funds building up. Staff will not receive money as bonus.

Funds Request for 3rd grade Scholastic News Edition put forth by Kourtney Williams, to support FSA reading goals. \$581 for the year subscription (83 students) approved at 3:20.

Funds Request for ILC to use for rewarding individual growth towards ELA/Math goals. \$1000 was approved at 3:21.

Plan to send out last year's School Climate Plan SAC Survey before December SAC Meeting to approve at January SAC Meeting.
